Medics At Home was formed in late 2010 as a provider of EMT & Paramedic services for events of any size (sporting events, fairs, concerts, corporate gatherings). In April of 2011 Brian Townsend, President & CEO of Medics At Home, worked with the state to become a Transport ALS Service.

Brian stated, “Although the Omaha market has other private EMS services, it is our opinion that the aging population is underserved. By offering non-emergency transport services in conjunction with other EMS services, Medics At Home’s goal is to become a top provider in Omaha and excel not only in patient care, but customer service.”

Medics At Home is currently providing transport and standby services in the state of Nebraska, but has plans on expanding to Iowa and other surrounding states. Brian added, “You will see more in the future about Community Paramedics, and this is a service we are working on that will greatly benefit the patient, especially in rural communities where access to care is limited. We plan on this being a future franchise option with Medics At Home, with the goal of helping smaller communities keep entrepreneurs and EMS personnel from moving to the bigger city.”
